

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES

The City of Urbandale is beginning the 86th Street Preservation Project to improve the condition and driving surface of this major route. Starting Monday, April 16th, work will begin to patch and overlay 86th Street. The project will take about two months.

PROJECT LIMITS: The project will extend from Aurora Avenue to the North City Limits (north of Northpark Drive). There will be periods of noise and lane closures.

CONTRACTOR: The prime contractor is Des Moines Asphalt and Paving.

PHASE 1: 86th Street will be under road construction for full-depth patching starting **Monday, April 16th**. Expect single lane closures along 86th Street both northbound and southbound from Aurora Avenue to I-80/35, and in the southbound lanes from I-80/35 to the City Limits. One lane will always remain open in each direction. This phase will also include sidewalk repairs and is expected to last a couple weeks.

PHASE 2: Patching and HMA overlay operations will require some full closures of 86th Street. Advanced notice will be posted for closures. Closures will primarily be done at night and/or on weekends to limit impact to residents and businesses. Detours will be posted.

ACCESS: Access will be provided for residences along the road during road closures. Every effort will be made to minimize the impact, but there will be some inconvenience. The goal is to work both safely and quickly. Please be patient and work with the contractors.

CONSTRUCTION: As always, please use caution when driving through a construction zone. Tack oil will be placed just before the asphalt paving. Local residents should avoid driving on the tack oil. If crossing the tack oil is unavoidable for access, please drive slowly.
