

Urbandale City Council Minutes  
July 27, 2010

The Urbandale City Council met in special session on Tuesday, July 11, 2010, at 6:00 p.m. at Urbandale City Hall, 3600 86<sup>th</sup> Street, with Mayor Robert D. Andeweg presiding. Answering roll call were the following Council Members: Mike Carver, John Forbes, Tom Gayman, Ron Pogge, Mary Polson. Absent: none. Also present were City Manager A.J. Johnson, Director of Engineering and Public Works Dave McKay, Assistant Director of Engineering John Larson, Assistant Director of Public Works Tim Stovie, City Clerk Deb Mains.

Mayor Andeweg recited the CHARACTER COUNTS! Statement.

Polson moved, seconded by Forbes to approve the Agenda as posted. On roll call, Ayes: Polson, Forbes, Carver, Gayman, Pogge. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Council Member Polson gave a status report regarding UCAN and the Urbandale Food Pantry. Polson indicated that the number of residents using the Food Pantry has greatly increased and asked for continued support, in the amount of \$20,000 annually for the next three years. Following discussion, the Council supported continued funding of the Food Pantry, subject to receipt of detailed financial statements and a listing of other funding sources on a regular basis.

John Larson reviewed the 2010 Street Management Program and outlined the process for updating the manual. Discussion was held regarding funding, pavement condition, future projects and concerns regarding rural asphalt roadways. A subcommittee will meet to discuss Meredith Drive and 156<sup>th</sup> Street prior to the beginning of the CIP process and will report back to Council.

Polson moved, seconded by Forbes to adjourn at 6:50 p.m. On roll call, Ayes: Polson, Forbes, Carver, Gayman. Nays: none. Motion carried.
