

Urbandale City Council Minutes
January 18, 2011

The Urbandale City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, January 18, 2011, at 11:45 a.m. at Urbandale City Hall, 3600 86th Street, with Mayor Robert D. Andeweg presiding. Answering roll call were the following Council Members: Tom Gayman, Mike Carver, John Forbes, Ron Pogge, Mary Polson. Absent: none. Also present were City Manager A.J. Johnson, Assistant City Manager Su Zanna K. Prophet, Assistant to the City Manager John Konior, Director of Engineering and Public Works Dave McKay, Assistant Director of Engineering John Larson, City Clerk Deb Mains.

Mayor Andeweg recited the CHARACTER COUNTS! Statement.

Polson moved, seconded by Pogge to approve the Agenda as posted. On roll call, Ayes: Polson, Pogge, Gayman, Forbes, Carver. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Dave McKay reviewed the history of the 73rd Place stormwater issues. Tony Belizzi, Veenstra and Kimm, reviewed the engineering study, including objectives, watershed areas, storm sewer capacity and condition, runoff estimates, possible remedies and estimated costs. The improvement project has been included in the Capital Improvements Program, spread over the next several years.

Dave McKay reviewed the concerns of several property owners at 64th Street and Hickory Lane regarding erosion of the creek behind their homes. Steve Belknap, representing the property owners shared photos outlining the progression of the erosion. Staff has recommended that federal monies be sought for funding a stabilization project for the creek. Formal action will be considered by the City Council at its meeting on January 25, 2011.
