

Urbandale City Council Minutes  
February 19, 2018

The Urbandale City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, February 19, 2019, at 11:45 a.m. at Urbandale City Hall, 3600 86<sup>th</sup> Street, with Mayor Robert D. Andeweg presiding. Answering roll call were the following Council Members: Mike Carver, Creighton Cox, Tom Gayman. Absent: Ron Pogge, David Russell. Also present were City Manager A.J. Cox moved, seconded by Gayman to approve the Agenda as posted. On roll call, Ayes: Cox, Gayman, Carver. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Matt Carlile, Consultant from Confluence, presented the Entry Signage Master Plan Review. Mr. Carlile highlighted the planning process including inventory & site selection, precedents, signage types, design selection and cost overview. Nicci Lamb outlined the project funding from GO Bonds and the operational adjustments required if the project does not move forward. Following discussion, staff was directed to bring the Entry Signage Master Plan Review to the next regular City Council meeting for consideration and official action.

Jan Herke presented the vendor rendering of the All-inclusive playground and reported on updated bids for the project including a water fountain. Fundraising is close to accomplished for the project; it has received overwhelming community support.

AJ Johnson discussed the approved Capital Improvements Program, requesting that any desired changes from the planning document be brought to staff prior to securing funding.
