Pool or Spa Acknowledgement Form

This form should be submitted with the **Building Permit Application** for a pool or spa. See **Residential Swimming Pool & Spa Plan Review & Inspections Schedule** handout for additional requirements.

Pools or spas must be enclosed by a fence or protected by a power safety cover.

Check one:

- A fence will be used for protection and doors with direct access to the pool will have an audible alarm.
 - Fence Built by: Pool Contractor
 - Fence Contractor
 - Homeowner
- A power safety cover meeting ASTM F 1346 will be used for protection and the power safety cover product information sheet is attached.

CHLORINATED pools or spas may drain to the sanitary sewer or discharge onto the homeowner's yard. (see "Draining Pools and Spas" handout for additional information.)

Check One:

- This is a Chlorinated pool or spa that will discharge only to a sanitary sewer at a max rate of 50 gal per minute between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM. (Any other discharge rates or times must be reviewed and approved by Urbandale Engineering and Public Works)
- This is a Chlorinated pool or spa that will discharge onto the homeowners yard after chlorine has dissipated to 1ppm, ph 6.5 to 8, and total suspended solids less than 60mg/l.
- This chlorinated pool or spa has no discharge to the sanitary sewer, storm sewer or the yard. Any maintenance draining will go to the sanitary sewer.

SALT WATER pools or spas MUST drain ONLY to the sanitary sewer. (see "Draining Pools and Spas" handout for additional information.)

Check One:

- This is a Salt water pool or spa and discharge will only be to a sanitary sewer at a max rate of 50 gal per minute during 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM. (Any other discharge rates or times must be reviewed and approved by Urbandale Engineering and Public Works)
- This salt water pool or spa has no discharge to the sanitary sewer, storm sewer or the yard. Any maintenance draining will go to the sanitary sewer.
